## Challenging Behaviors in Respite Care:

Understanding behaviors across ages and strategies to decrease challenging behaviors

Respite care providers report they are not well enough supported and lack adequate training to address challenging behaviors. They are not always sure where the behaviors come from or how to address or respond to the challenging behaviors. This free 4-part Webinar Series will address these issues along a continuum of ages: Children, Adolescents, Adults, and Older Adults.

**Respite care** is defined as short term or temporary care of a few hours or weeks for an individual with a disability or illness. It is designed to provide relief or “respite” to the regular caregiver.

Attendees will learn practical strategies and speakers will cover information related to a number of special health care needs across the disability and behavioral health spectrum. The intended audience for this Webinar Series is anyone who provides care for another individual, such as professional respite providers and family members. All are welcome!
