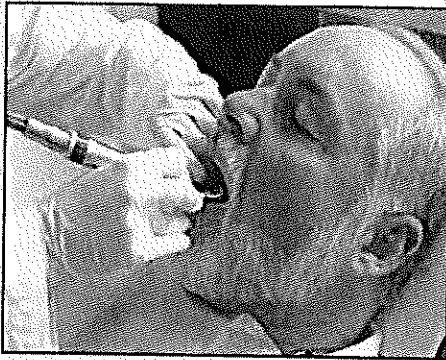
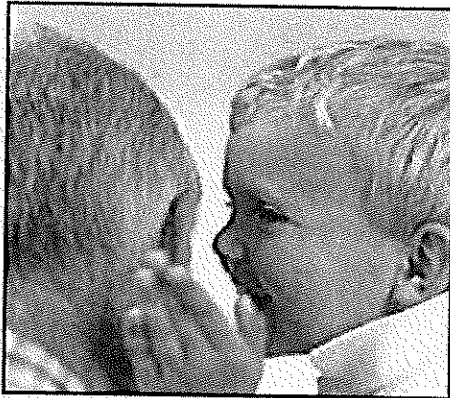


Grants Available for Seniors 60+

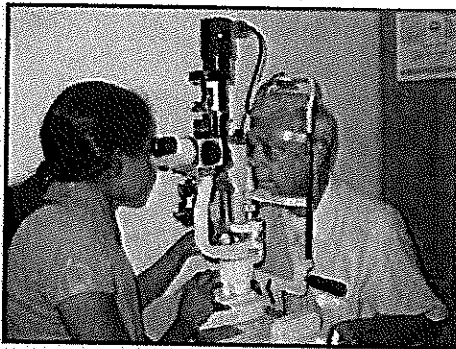
Denver Metro area seniors who are age 60+ and living in one of the following counties (Adams, Arapahoe, Broomfield, Clear Creek, Denver, Douglas, Gilpin, or Jefferson) are eligible for limited financial assistance for dental services, hearing aids and eyeglasses. To request grant assistance or for more information, call 303-333-3482 for a grant assessment form.



The **Dental Program** can cover most basic services including dentures, partials, fillings, extractions, exams, and x-rays. The program will not pay for implants and bridges.



The **Hearing Program** can help individuals purchase hearing aids by providing up to \$790 per hearing aid and \$85 per ear mold, with a maximum of two each. The program does not fund cochlear implants.



The **Vision Program** gives grants for a basic eye exam, frames, and lenses up to trifocals. The program cannot cover progressive lenses, tints, contact lenses, or other optical services.
