WHAT IS IT?



The Supported Living Services (SLS) Medicaid Waiver provides a variety of services and supports for adults (ages 18+) living in their own homes or with family in the community.

The services provided include personal assistance with daily living activities and homemaking skills, as well as supports in the community through employment, professional services, and transportation. Currently, there is no waitlist for this program.

AM I ELIGIBLE?



- At least 18 years or older
- Determined to have a developmental disability by a Community Centered Board
- Needs support completing some or all activities of daily living
- Meets Social Security disability criteria
- Income (work & non-work) must not exceed \$2,205/month
- Individuals must have less than \$2,000 in countable resources; Couples less than \$3,000
